- 6. Don't try to win the argument.
- 7. Over-react as long it is justified.
- 8. Don't worry about trying to create a consensus.
- 9. When possible involve not only friends but enemies as well.
- 10. Stay vigilant!

Points: Learn lessons from the situation and keep your staff informed on the situation.
