Minutes of the 12 June 2014, 11:30 a.m. Meeting

Report/Action Items:

1. Minutes of the May8, 2014 meeting were reviewed and unanimously approved as presented.
2. Dale Hendrix presented the current financial report. End of month (May) account balance was \$1,128.04. The financial report was unanimously accepted as presented.
3. End of Year Charitable Disbursements. Dave Thomas reminded members that in May we voted to disburse \$600, but delayed the decision for which organizations we would donate to until this month. The membership nominated and unanimously approved these two organizations this year: Stillwater Christian Ministries (www.swcm.org) and Methodist Children's Home (www.methodistchildrenshome.org).
4. Dave Thomas reviewed the chapter meeting schedule and reminded members the NACBA National Conference in Orlando next month and that the chapter offices would meet to build next year's calendar of events. There is no chapter meeting in July. The location of the August meeting is not yet known.
5. **Program: Methodist Children's Home (MCH)**
Jessica Butters, MCH Outreach Director, gave a presentation about the services provided and how churches could help meet the needs of the San Antonio MCH. It's a private organization that relies on donations and funding via an endowment fund. MCH serves 1400 children per day between birth and 14 years of age. Foster families are one of its greatest needs. Churches can help by informing their members of the organization's existence and encouraging them to get involved.
6. Comments: Dave asked Norm to represent the ALAMO Chapter at the NACBC Chapter President's Luncheon while at the national conference. Debbie Vignes shared that her church is helping to sponsor the feeding of the 4 million, and encouraged sister churches to help by sending volunteers September 25-28. Call Debbie for further details: 210-696-1033. Sharon Hardie reported that she completed her PhD classes and now has to finish her dissertation.
7. Dave Thomas closed by sharing Joys and Concerns, and praying for Darla Nelson's dad and Debbie Vignes' dad.
